mentioned William Gaither before us two of the Justices of the Peace for Frederick Coun-  
ty and acknowledged the within instrument of writing to be his Act and Deed and the  
Cords and promises therein mentioned to be the right Interest and Estate of the within men-  
tioned James Correa his heirs and assigns forever according to the Intent and meaning  
thereof and the Acts of Assembly in such Cases made and provided -----

At the request of Negro Charles the following Manu-  
mission was recorded 9<sup>th</sup> June 1795. to wit.

Know all men by these Presents that I Henry Brown of Frederick in  
the state of Maryland for divers good causes and considerations me hereunto  
moving have manumitted enfranchised and set free and by these presents do  
manumit enfranchise and set free my Negro Slave Charles aged about sixteen  
years to be free when he shall arrive at the full age of twenty one years then to be free  
and exempt from all manner of service whatsoever. In witness whereof I have pur-  
suant to set my hand and seal this fourth day of June 1795.

was recorded 9<sup>th</sup> June 1795. to wit.

This Indenture made this twenty seventh day of May one thousand seven hun-  
dred and ninety five Between John Spoon of Frederick County and State of Maryland  
Carpenter of the one part and Peter Hook of the same County and State aforesaid of the  
other part. Witnesseth that the said John Spoon for and in consideration of the sum  
of three Pounds nine shillings and nine pence current Money to him in hand paid  
by the said Peter Hook at or before the enrolling and Delivery of these Presents  
the Receipt whereof the said John Spoon doth hereby acknowledge that he  
gives, granted Bargained and sold Alien'd, Released Enfeoff'd, and confirmed
