Confirmed And by these presents doth give, grant, bargain and sell, Alieu
Nolans Enfeoff and confirm unto him the said Peter Houk his heirs and Assigns

to the aforesaid John Spoon by Deed bearing date the third Day of June One thousand seven
hundred and ninety three and recorded among the Land Records of Frederick County as
appears &c. Beginning for the part hereby intended to be conveyed at the end of the twelfth
line of Peter Houks part of a Tract of Land called CONTENT and running thence with
said line reversed North five degrees West fifty one perches then south Eighty five Degrees West
four and a half perches Then south five degrees East eleven perches North eighty five
Degrees East half a perch then south five degrees East forty six perches then by a
straight line to the beginning containing One Acre and three Eighths of an Acre of
Land Together with all and singular the Buildings and Improvements Advan-
tages, Acciditaments, and Appurtenances whatsoever to the said piece Part or parcel
of Land and Premises belonging or in any wise appertaining, and all the Estate Right
Title property Interest claim and Demand whatsoever of time the said John Spoon
of in and to the above described piece or parcel of Land and premises and every
