At the Request of Conrad Snyder and Fred Bachman the  
following Act of Assembly was Recited: October 2. 1798. to wit.

Articles of Agreement made and concluded on, this — day of  
February seventeen hundred ninety seven. Between Frederick Bachman  
Conrad Snyder, John Low & Conrad Leister Witnesses that Whereas the  
subscribers have lands adjoining each other, and there may disputes  
hereafter arise concerning the location and situation of the said lands  
and being desirous of fixing the same, by setting up boundaries and  
marking the lines, so as to prevent all disputes hereafter and that  
each may know the situation of his land. It is therefore agreed  
by these presents by us the subscribers parties to this Agreement  
that the lines of Conrad Snyder's land which lie adjacent and contiguous  
to our respective lands, as run, marked, and bounded by Joel Wright in  
the year 1795, for the out lines of the said Snyder's land shall  
continue to be the fixed location thereof according to the original &  
that the said stones now fixed at the corners and lines marked shall  
remain to be the permanent location. And it is further agreed that the  
plat and certificate of the said lands so laid out, and boundaries estab-  
lished shall be returned to Frederick county court there to be recorded  
as Evidence of the same. And that each of the subscribers under the  
penalty of five hundred dollars demandable by and payable to the  
subscribers agreeing to such plat and certificate for the benefit of the  
party agreeing shall agree to the same. In Testimony whereof  
the subscribers hereunto set their hands & seals the day and year aforesaid.

I hereby certify that in the year 1795, or thereabouts, I surveyed, marked  
& bounded for Conrad Snyder the following lands situate in Fred. County &  
contiguous to each other viz. part of Old survey for Samuel  
Owings the 22<sup>d</sup> of March 1776. Geo. Wisenburgh granted Sabel Snyder  
July 31<sup>st</sup> 1764. and part of Addition granted Caprell Snyder the 22<sup>d</sup> of  
Feb<sup>y</sup> 1765. with an allowance of 2 1/2<sup>o</sup> for variation agreeable to the  
courses for said lands contained in a deed of conveyance from said  
Conrad Snyder to George Humbert made on or about the year 1796.
