with certain Arthur McGuigan are Defendants on or before the first day July
next ensuing the Date of these Presents And shall also save harmless and
Indemnify the said Raphael Brooke and Joseph Toney from all Damages Costs
and Costs whatsoever that they or either of them may be Subjected to by reason
of their being bound in a Supersedeas of the Judgment aforesaid Then these Presents
and every matter Clause and Thing herein contained shall cease Determine and be
utterly Null and Void to all Intents and Purposes whatsoever But in case
the said Adam Good should fail to pay the Amount of the Judgment aforesaid
Together with the Costs thereon and the same should remain unsatisfied on the
first day of July next aforesaid that then and in such case it shall and may be
Lawfull and the said Adam Good doth hereby Grant and Agree that the said
Raphael Brooke and Joseph Toney or either of them shall and may Take Seize
and Sell the said Negro Slaves before described and out of the Money arising
from the Sale thereof to satisfy and pay the Amount of the Judgment aforesaid
to the said Jacob Munday his Executors Administrators or Assigns rendering the
Overplus (if any) to the same Adam Good his Executors Administrators or Assigns
And the said Adam Good for himself and my heirs Executors and Administrators do hereby
covenant and Agree to warrant and Defend the said Negro Slaves unto the said
Raphael Brooke and Joseph Toney their Executors Administrators and Assigns forever
Subject Nevertheless to the Condition and Proviso herein before Inserted In
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Affixed my Seal this fourth
day of January in the Year of our Lord Eighteen Hundred and one

Four Hundred and fifty Pounds Current Money to him in hand paid by
the said William Hawk the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge and
himself to be therewith fully satisfied and paid Hath given granted bargained
sold and confirmed and by these Presents doth give grant bargain sell and
confirm unto the said William Hawk his heirs and Assigns all that Tract or
(Parcel)
