of the County aforesaid and State of Maryland of the other part
Whereas the said Margaret Hauck and Michael Hauck as aforesaid
said by virtue of the power invested in them by the will of the
aforesaid Peter Hauck bearing date the thirteenth day of January
Seventeen hundred and ninety eight and recorded in the Register
office of the County aforesaid reference being thereunto had well
more fully and at large appear by virtue of which aforesaid
Will they the said Margaret Hauck & Michael Hauck as
Executors as aforesaid did on the twelfth day of March Eighteen
hundred and one sell to the said John Hauck (of Peter) all that
part of a Lot or portion of ground known and distinguished by number
one hundred and thirty three lying and being in Frederick Town
Frederick County and State aforesaid with all and singular the
Improvements thereon or thereunto belonging at and for the price or sum
of Fifty pounds current Money Now this Indenture witnesseth
that the said Margaret Hauck and Michael Hauck in considera-
tion of the promises aforesaid and by virtue of the Authority in them
invested by the aforesaid Will hath sold aliened and confirmed
and by virtue of the aforesaid Will doth sell alien and confirm
unto him the aforesaid John Hauck (of Peter) all the aforesaid
